WHERE CAN I SEE THE SALMON?

The **Issaquah Salmon Hatchery**, located off of West Sunset Way in downtown, is the most popular spot to watch the salmon returning upstream.

The Issaquah Salmon Hatchery was completed in 1937 as a Works Progress Administration project. Today, the Issaquah hatchery is the most-visited state hatchery, with up to 350,000 visitors a year. Friends of the Issaquah Salmon Hatchery (FISH) trains guides who amaze visitors with the depth of their knowledge about the Northwest salmon life cycle, the importance of watershed stewardship and the operations of the historic hatchery.







The Salmon Days Festival was spawned in 1970, out of a desire to celebrate one of Issaquah's greatest treasures - the annual return of the salmon.


