

# 2026 Salmon Days Festival

## Load In & Load Out

### Information

---

Festival Hours are **10 am to 6 pm Saturday, October 3<sup>rd</sup> and Sunday, October 4<sup>th</sup>**. ALL booths must be open during festival hours and must close promptly at 6 pm each day.

**Note: If your booth # is in the 600s OR 700s, you are located on the Field of Fun or Hatchery, respectively. This means you have the option of loading in on Friday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> starting at 1p. I suggest you take advantage of this extra day to set up leisurely, if possible.**

### **ALL PUBLIC STREETS WILL BE REOPENED OVERNIGHT.**

Please ensure that booths allow free flow of traffic in both directions.

**The Festival streets are open to all traffic until 6:00 AM on Saturday.** Once streets close to the public, **vendors will need to have their 'Access Pass'** displayed on their dashboard to be allowed in. Access to the Festival area can become slowed as you pass through the Police roadblocks and other vendor traffic. Use caution and be courteous during setup. Booth spaces will be clearly marked. Please stay within your assigned designated area. **Neighboring businesses may be open during your setup and the Festival. Do not hinder their access.**

- **LOAD IN: SATURDAY, OCTOBER 3<sup>rd</sup>, 6:00 am to 9:00 am**
  - Booth Ohfishals, wearing reflective safety vests, will be available to help you find your space. Spaces will be marked by booth numbers. Please stay within your assigned designated area. **Your vehicle must be removed from the Festival area and legally parked by 9 am.**
  
- **LOAD OUT: SATURDAY, OCTOBER 3<sup>rd</sup>, after 6:00 pm**

*(Note: You are not required to load out on Saturday and may leave your booth and/or items within your tent at your own risk if you choose. I recommend you enclose your booth on all sides with sidewalls.)*

  - **Anything left in your booth overnight is left at your own risk.** If you wish to remove anything, your car must be loaded and out of traffic lanes by 7 pm.
  - Traffic resumes in the evening! **Awnings that extend beyond the front plane of your booth must be lowered or removed at night.** If not, they could be hit by a car when the roads are reopened in the evenings.

- **LOAD IN: SUNDAY, OCTOBER 4<sup>th</sup>, 6:00 am to 9:00 am**
  - You will not be allowed past the Police roadblocks after 8:00 am AND your vehicle **MUST** be off the Festival streets and legally parked by 8 am.
  
- **LOAD OUT: SUNDAY, OCTOBER 4<sup>th</sup>, after 6:00 pm**
  - Vendor vehicles are not allowed onto the Festival streets until after the Police Department deems it safe. **Please use the time between 6:00 pm and the time roads open on Sunday to dismantle and pack your booth, to the best of your ability, before you bring in your vehicle.** All booths must be off the street and cars able to legally park by 8:00 pm.
